Exercise of the Month:

Squats: from a standing position, bend knees and bend down until your thighs are parallel to the floor, hold for a second and stand up again. Repeat 15 times and work up to 30, and then 50.

Recipe of the Month:

Baked Mozzarella Bites: 1/3 cup panko(Japanese breadcrumbs), 3 (1 oz.) part-skim mozzarella string cheese sticks, 3 Tsp egg substitute, cooking spray, ¼ cup lower sodium marinara sauce.
Preheat oven to 425, Heat a medium skillet over medium heat. Add 1/3 cup panko to pan, cook for 2 minutes or until toasted, stirring frequently. Remove from heat and place the panko in a shallow dish. Cut mozzarella sticks into 1 inch pieces. Working with one piece at a time, dip cheese in egg substitute, dredge in panko. Place cheese on a baking sheet coated with cooking spray. Bake at 425 for 3 minutes or until the cheese is softened and thoroughly heated. Pour the marinara sauce in to a microwave-safe bowl. Microwave at HIGH 1 minute or until thoroughly heated, stirring after 30 seconds. Serve with mozzarella pieces.(From Cooking Light.)
